

REQUIREMENTS FOR PREGNANT MARES ARRIVING FOR FOALING SERVICES:

Foaling mares should arrive approximately 4 to 6 weeks prior to the estimated foaling date. This allows your mare to settle in mentally as well as giving her immune system time to adjust to new surroundings. This is important so that the antibody content of the colostrum is as high as possible.

Foaling mares should receive vaccination boosters for the abortive form of rhino on their 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th month of pregnancy. We are also recommending vaccination for Rotavirus on the 8th, 9th and 10th month of pregnancy. This helps prevent ONE of the contagious forms of diarrhea which can affect foals.

Pre foaling boosters are generally given 4 to 6 weeks prior to the estimated foaling date. These usually consist of annual vaccination boosters. Check with your veterinarian on what is recommended for your area. Remember: The American Association of Equine Practitioners recommends that rabies NOT be given to pregnant mares.
